BOOK REVIEW Deadly Secrets by Robert Tenison

A fast paced thriller about corruption and death in Andalucia.

Just on the verge of taking a stake in old friend and estate agent Mike Cameron's business, and wanting to find out more about a mysterious deal that is about to take place, Andy Montalvo arrives back in Los Cypreses to be told of his friend's death.

Not knowing whether it was an accident or a murder, Andy helps the organised crime unit of the Spanish police (UDYCO) investigate the case. Was it an accident, was Mike killed by his ex-wife and her lover or was it something much more sinister?

From Granada to London to the Caymen Islands, Andy, helped along by beautiful undercover Special Agent

Cristina Ibañez, uncovers corruption in high places over land and the re-zoning laws, bribery and corruption in local authorities and building companies, not to mention money laundering and murder with the body count rising at every turn.

Author Robert Tenison was born in the UK to Spanish parents. He was a commercial and investment banker himself for 15 years, including some time in the Cayman Islands so knows a great deal about his subject. For the last seven years he has been living and working in Southern Spain within the property and financial services sector.

This book, once started, is un-
